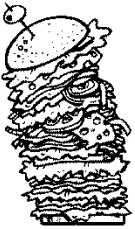


Thanksgiving in Lancaster County

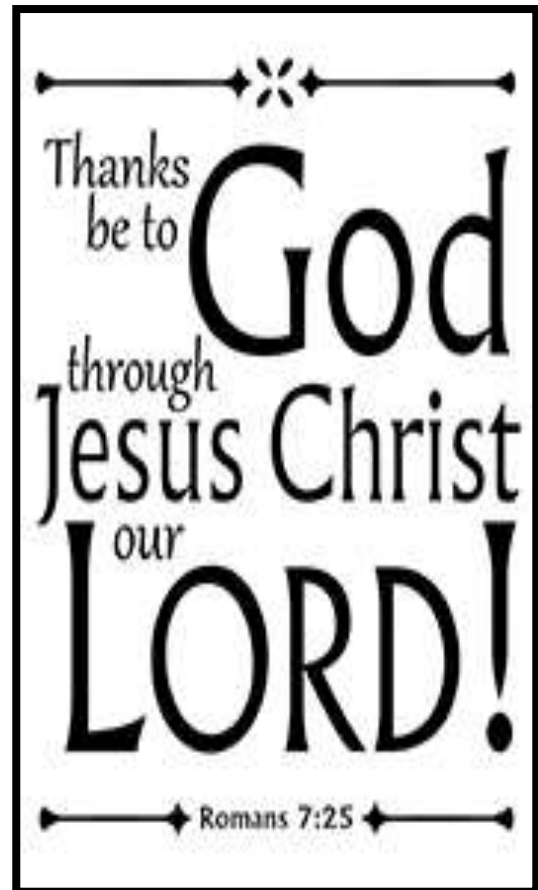
